BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING

The U.S.D. #354 Board of Education met on June 7, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. at the Claflin USD 354 District Office. Board members present were Doug Hubbard, Bert Besthorn, Dawnya Hickel, and Jim Vance.

The agenda for the June 7, 2010, meeting was approved. The minutes from the May meeting were approved along with the invoices, and the treasurer's report.

Under old business the board approved the following items: Joan Klug as an additional instructor for the summer 2010 academy; Sharkey Construction's from Otis, Kansas, low bid was approved to replace the concrete by the walk-in freezer and SW gym entrance at the high school; and a Kansas Warranty Deed to sell the baseball field to the City of Claflin.

Superintendent Jane Oeser reported that Stephanie Baltazar was hired as a science teacher at Claflin Jr/Sr High School and Jennifer Berg was hired to teach 1st-12th art. Superintendent Oeser also informed the board of the progress of the interim board with the consolidated district.

Principal Toby Holmes reported on the following: boy's state tennis results; state track results; 18 students currently enrolled in drivers education; drivers education class should be completed by June 23; custodial work at the high school going well with the assistance of the Wilson School custodians; capital outlay projects will be completed in July; new sewing camp sponsored by the Twisted Stitchers; and reviewed scheduled summer athletic camps with all being completed by July 16th so the gym floor can be refinished prior to the beginning of school.
