This scholarship will be awarded to student residents of Barton and Stafford counties, who show good citizenship and character, have average or above average grades, and who will be attending full-time at any accredited college or university. Interest and desire to attend college will be considered, as well as financial need.

The application for this scholarship should be typed and double-spaced. For this application to be considered complete, the following must be included:

- Your name and address.
- Parents names and address/addresses
- A personal letter describing your college plans, telling why you believe you deserve this scholarship.
- List of school activities (community activities, honors and awards, other scholarships received).
- Official transcript of grades, and ACT or SAT scores.
- List of honors and awards.
- List of any other scholarships that you may have been awarded.
- Letter of acceptance from an accredited college or university, if possible.
- A copy of the most recent federal income tax return (form 1040, 1040A, or 1040EZ, pages 1 and 2 only) for parents and dependent student applicants, or for independent students not claimed by parents as dependents. Strict confidence will be maintained of this information.

The completed application, including references, should be returned to the appropriate office at the high school. **Applications are due by March 15.**
